## *CLWA helps Large Landscape Sites Conserve Water*



In the Santa Clarita Valley, a high percentage of water is used for outdoor irrigation. In an effort to help reduce this outdoor water use, CLWA designed a program committed to helping large landscape sites conserve water throughout the year.

By participating in the Large Landscape Program, Home Owners Associations (HOA) and property managers can help reduce water waste while simultaneously lowering water bills. Landscapers are also encouraged to participate in the program. The training and certification can help increase business for landscapers since many local homeowners are interested in learning new ways to save water in their yards.



The program provides landscape contractors with an onsite demonstration of ways to improve watering efficiency. CLWA will work with landscapers to select sites that meet the large landscape specifications. At these sites, a survey will be performed and water-saving equipment, including a weather based irrigation controller and high efficiency sprinkler nozzles, will be provided. Training for on-site maintenance personnel will also be offered.

Maintenance personnel and their contractors/companies can attend a three hour water efficiency training workshop where they will be trained in the classroom and in the field.

## *CLWA Classes Leading up to 30% Water Savings*



Classes are offered in both English and Spanish. After completing the training, each attendee, as well as their staff or landscape company, will receive official certification for attending the workshop and committing to water efficient practices at their sites. Combined, these features could lead to water savings of up to 30 percent annually.
